If you've decided to upgrade a Windows XP, Windows Vista or Windows 7 machine to Windows 8, you probably want to make sure your system can support Windows 8 sooner buy the update. To check if your computer supports Windows 8, you can download and run the Windows 8 Update Wizard. The Update Wizard will go ahead and scan your hardware, programs, and even connected devices to make sure they will work with Windows 8. Windows 8 requires certain CPU features such as PAE, NX, SSE2, etc., so it's a good idea to use this tool if your computer is a little on the older side. The tool will also give you a compatibility report for your programs and let you know if you need to uninstall the program or update the program before upgrading. Once downloaded, install and run it, the program will automatically start scanning your computer for apps and devices. It will then tell you which apps are supported and which apps to review. There are some new features in Windows 8 such as safe boot, snap, and quick startup. The Update Wizard will notify you if any of these items aren't compatible with your system: If you didn't already know, Windows 8 doesn't include built-in software to play DVDs. If you want that feature, you'll need to buy the pro pack and get Windows Media Center.
